PENTECOST "101"

Pentecost is a celebration of the Holy Spirit's sustaining grace and power. It takes place each church year on the 50th day following Easter Sunday. The English word "Pentecost" comes from the Greek words "pentekoste hemera", meaning "the fiftieth day." It's a time for Christians to celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit—God's continuing presence in the world.

Drawn from the Biblical account in Acts 2, the main symbols of Pentecost and the Holy Spirit are:

WIND: A symbol of great power in nature and a sign of life itself.

FIRE: Also a symbol of great power and an element necessary for life.

The color of Pentecost is red, representing the fire of Pentecost and the blood of the martyrs.

Christians came to understand the meaning of Pentecost in terms of the gift of the Spirit. The Pentecost event was the fulfillment of a promise which Jesus gave concerning the return of the Holy Spirit. The speaking in tongues, which was a major effect of having received the Spirit is interpreted by some to symbolize the church's worldwide preaching.
