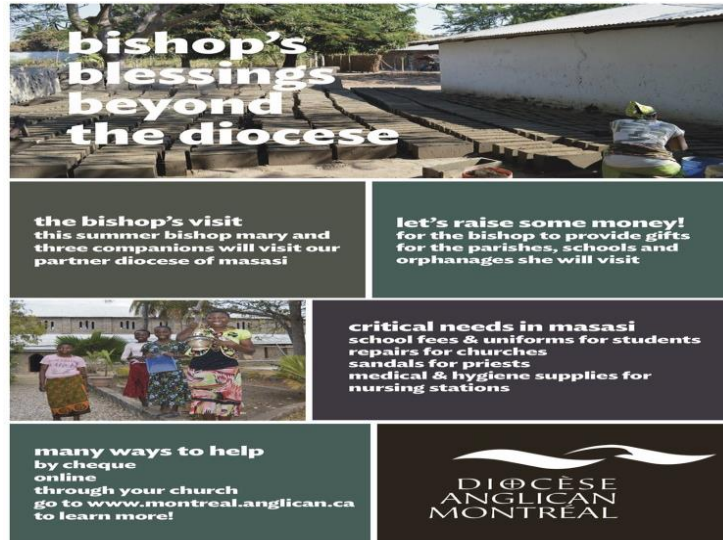

She hopes to have funds to provide small gifts for the many communities that she will visit. Some families in Masasi live on less than a dollar a day so the church is one of the biggest providers of social and economic supports to meet basic needs.

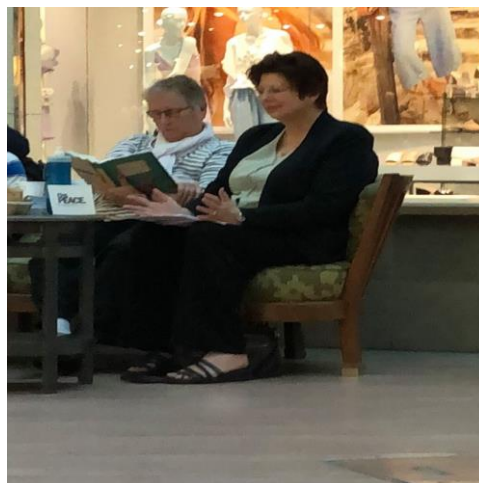
Thy Kingdom Come
