NOTICE OF SPECIAL VESTRY MEETING

Dear Members of St. George's,

The wardens, in conversation with Archdeacon Michelle Eason, are calling a special vestry meeting to be held on Sunday November 18, 2018 at noon (following the worship) in the Parish Hall. All members of the parish are invited to attend. Those who meet canonical requirements can vote (must be at least 16 years of age and are currently communicants). The Vestry will nominate and elect a Parish Selection Committee who will work together to select a new Incumbent. The role of the Parish Selection Committee is to provide advice to the Bishop on the appointment of a cleric to fill the vacancy.

This committee will be comprised of 2 wardens, one elected and one appointed, and 5 parishioners. The Wardens' intent is to have a strong and representative selection committee, with the confidence and support of the parish.

Please note that as per Diocesan Policy, proxy votes are not allowed.
