Stewardship

It's a new year. Already? There are always so many things to be done and we never seem to have enough time to complete all the things we want to finish. A common wish-list item is to be better at stewardship.

We want to be better and kinder to the planet and those who reside here. There is so much work to do and we can't do it all, so we look to the groups and organizations who are doing it with the hope that we can support them with money or as a volunteer. Again, more needs to be done than we have time or money to accomplish.

I think many of us face this dilemma and just give up because we don't think we can effect the change we want to see. In the end, we can't, at least not by ourselves. I am reminded of the baptismal vows and a familiar recurring line is "I will, with God's help."

As we begin our new year I think it is important to remember that we can't do it all, and certainly not without help. I also believe that "God' help" is often provided by those around us. For example, look at the improvements made to the church and the rectory this past year. Many of God's helpers have taken on roles to see important work being done for the physical structure of St. George's. We cannot change the world by ourselves, it only happens with God's help and we are the ones responsible to see that it happens. For this "New Year" I ask that you think about what needs doing "With God's help" and help God get it done.
