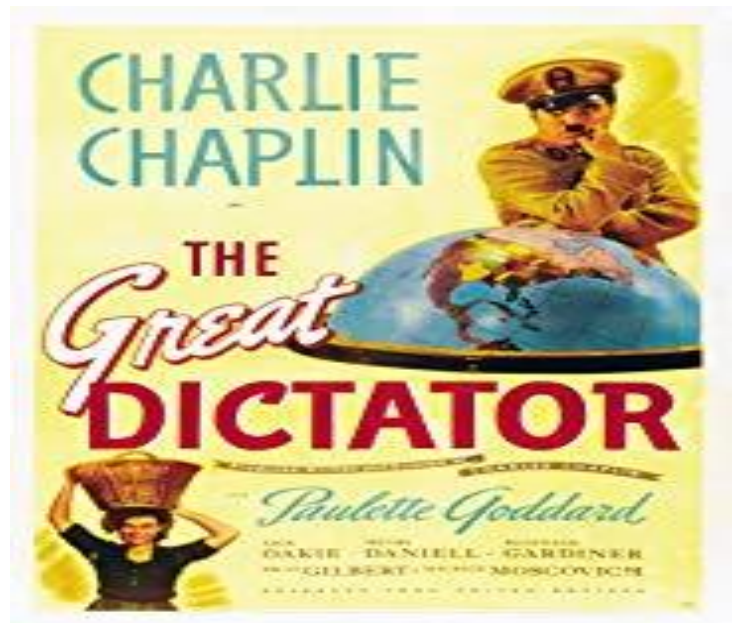

- † Voted to accept the deficit budget at \$13,000 for 2019
- † Noted that \$600 was donated by parishioners to the Bishop's Blessings Beyond in 2018
- † For reasons of continuity, the leadership team remains the same for the coming year
- † We learned that the Parish Selection Committee will be holding meetings to discuss the results of the survey that has been circulated
- † Discussed the formation of a Worship Committee. Members will have input into the liturgy of the Sunday worship services – within the Anglican tradition
