## Maternal Health Symposium for PWRDF and local Birthing Centre!

The Anglican Diocese of Montreal's PWRDF Unit – together with the MUCH Foundation - has organised an exciting event in the Glen, on **May 15<sup>th</sup> 2019** from 5:30 to 7:30pm. At the Maternal Health Symposium, you will:

- hear from MUHC experts who specialize in high-risk and complex care for pregnant women and their unborn babies
- learn from humanitarian teams working in East Africa to reduce illness and death among newborns and women of reproductive age
- hear from an MUHC patient who experienced firsthand the critical care that saved her and her newborn's life
