

West Island Mission Back To School Event

At West Island Mission, as soon as school is out, the planning begins for their annual Back to School event.

This year their Back to School distribution will be taking place on August 11. In order for this event to be a success, they need your help in several areas. They have 220 families enrolled with 465 school-aged children who will be receiving backpacks and school supplies. These numbers are up significantly from last year. Once again, they are promoting their "Sponsor a Backpack" program and are looking to the community for help in raising the necessary funds to cover the cost. For \$20, which is the average cost of the backpack filled with basic school supplies, you can provide a backpack to one of the students registered to receive this year. Larger donations can also be made to help provide for additional backpacks (a \$60 donation will cover the cost of 3 backpacks).
